1 Junior Professorship (W1, without tenure track) in Social Science Research Methods

We are looking for a social scientist who has proven his/her scientific aptitude through outstanding work in his/her doctoral studies. Candidates for this position should have very good skills in social science research methods. International work experiences, scientific publications in international academic journals as well as teaching experience are desirable. Successful candidates will be expected to qualify for the position of a university professor by doing independent research and teaching in their respective area of expertise. The successful candidate will be integrated into the interdisciplinary research network of the Graduate School.

The Junior Professor will be located at the Cologne Graduate School (CGS) in Management, Economics, and Social Sciences. Together with the other professors of the CGS, the successful candidate is responsible for the methods education of the faculty's PhD students that come from all disciplines represented at the faculty. It is expected that he/she provides courses in research design, case-oriented (comparative) methods or specialized courses for the analysis of survey data. Cologne Graduate School's classes are held in English. The successful candidate should also contribute to the academic life of the CGS (Brown Bag Seminar and other scientific events).

Junior Professors are employed for three years. An extension for another three years is possible based on performance evaluation. Applications from people with disabilities are welcome. Handicapped candidates who are equally well qualified for the job will be given priority. Female applicants are encouraged to apply and will be given priority for equal qualification.
