



## Call for Contributed Papers Workshop on Probability-Based and Nonprobability Survey Research June 25-26, 2018 in Mannheim, Germany

We are inviting applications for contributed papers to our workshop on Probability-Based and Nonprobability Survey Research. This workshop will bring together experts on probability-based and nonprobability survey research to discuss the latest developments and foster international collaborations.

Accepted contributed papers will be presented at the workshop at the University of Mannheim on June 25-26, 2018. Presentations should address methodological issues related to probability-based and nonprobability survey data. We especially encourage contributions on:

- Accuracy of probability-based versus nonprobability survey data
- Measurement error in probability-based versus nonprobability surveys
- Attrition in probability-based versus nonprobability panels
- Total Survey Error assessments in probability-based and nonprobability surveys
- Adjustment procedures for probability-based and nonprobability survey data

## How to submit an abstract

Abstracts (max. 350 words) should be submitted via email to <u>conference@reforms.uni-mannheim.de</u> by **April 8, 2018**. Please provide the title of the paper, author names, and affiliations with your abstract. Presentations on work in progress are encouraged.

Applicants will be notified of the acceptance of their abstracts by mid-April 2018. Registration for accepted presenters will also open in mid-April 2018.

The workshop will be free of charge. Participants are asked to pay for their own travel arrangements and accommodation.
